2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the CYA prescriptions and the class rules except if they are changed by the regatta notice of race or the sailing instructions.

This is a category C event as described in the RRS.

3. Eligibility

Competitors will be required to show compliance with rule 75 by presenting proof of membership in a club that is currently a member in good standing with the CYA. A membership card is the normal method of proof.

The competitors shall also show proof of membership to their respective class association. Membership card will be available, on site, from the class representatives – Oliver Bone for the 470 Class and Claudia Strobel for the Europe class.

4. Entries

The entry fee is \$75 per sailor and includes the Friday night BBQ. Please note that no lunches will be supplied.

The registration form and entry fees shall be provided on site at the LRYC during the registration period. Registration will take place on Wednesday September 22 from 17:00 to 19:00 and on Thursday September 23 from 8:00 to 9:00.

6. Scoring

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. A maximum of 15 races are scheduled; one race will constitute a series.

When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

7. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in the following categories: 470 open, 470 men, 470 women and Europe open.

8. CYA discipline code

It is expected all athletes and coaches attending this regatta will respect and adhere to the CYA Discipline Code.

9. Safety

Competitors shall wear lifejackets or other adequate personal buoyancy at all time while afloat. This change rule 40 of the RRS.

10. Measurement

The class associations are responsible for measurement. All certificates must be on hand for random measurement checks.

11. Accommodation

Camping is allowed on the yacht club propriety. Limited billets will be available on a first come first serve basis. Please contact LRYC, **before August 20**, if you would like to be billeted by a yacht club member.
